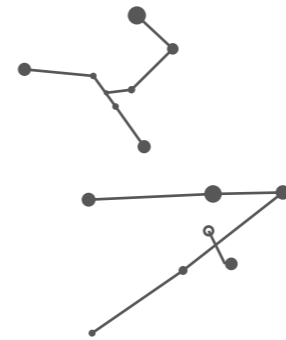

### 2. Things we would like you to note

- Unfortunately, thefts and pickpocketing incidents have occurred on the day of the university festival in previous years. Please be aware that the executive committee cannot be held responsible for any thefts, losses, or accidents that may occur.
  - Please be aware of individuals or groups impersonating as clubs, volunteer groups, alumni, etc. and attempting to forcefully solicit or ask for personal information.
- If you see a suspicious person on the day of the festival, please contact the festival headquarters immediately. Also, we do not allow unauthorized persons to enter the festival for the purpose of solicitation, etc.

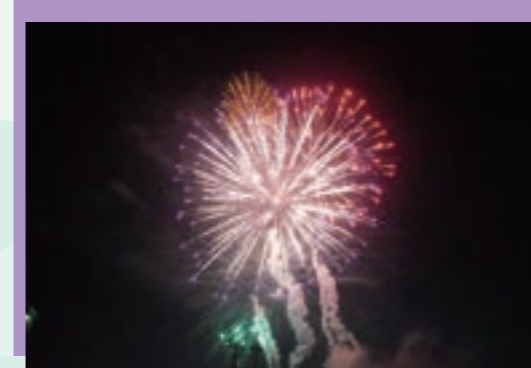
About the logo mark

The Ritsumeikan University Festival will kick off at the Osaka Ibaraki Campus, which is at the forefront of community-based social initiatives

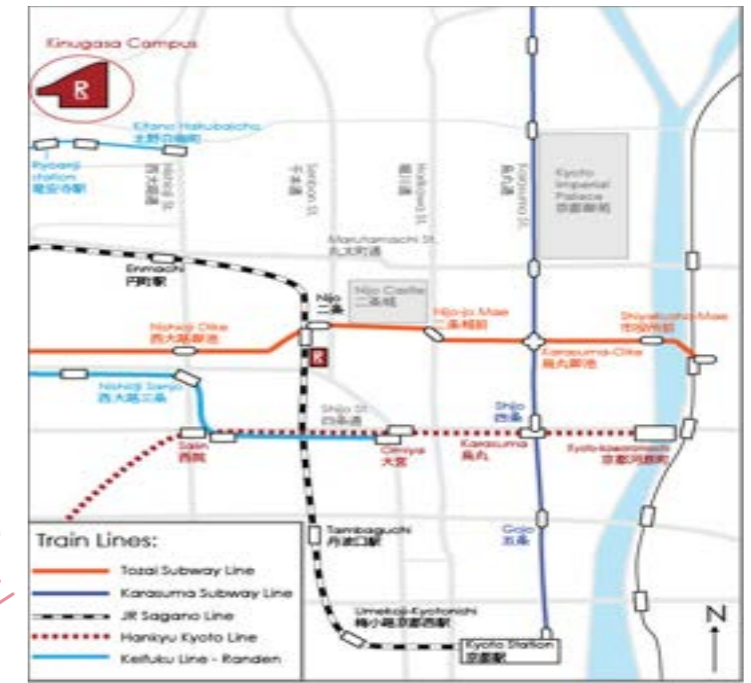
Next, the Kinugasa Campus, located in the ancient capital of Kyoto, has a history and tradition that dates back to 1965

Please enjoy the unexpected experiences that await you at these three unique campuses We hope you will enjoy the 2024 Ritsumeikan University School Festival.



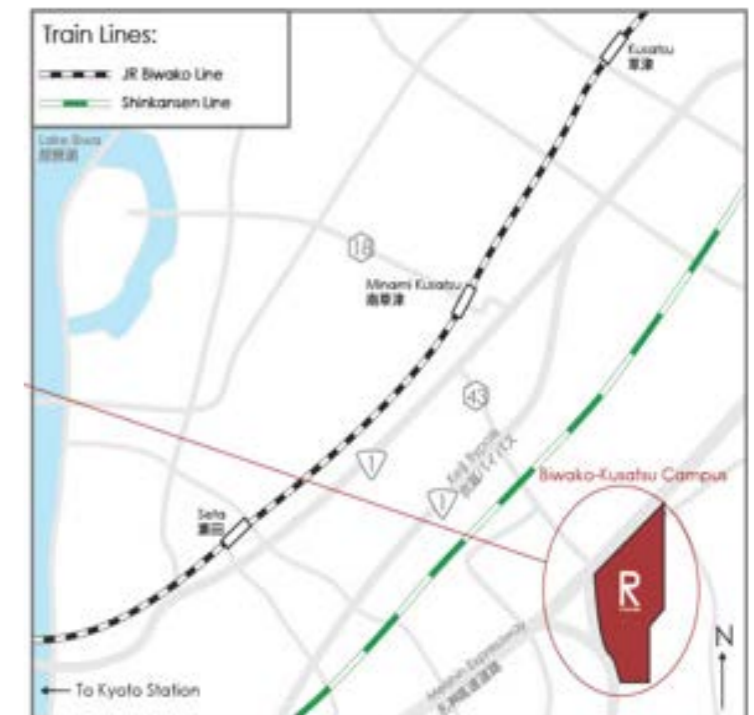

This page introduces the efforts being made at this year's festival.

## Eco Tray

At the Kinugasa Festival, we use eco-friendly trays for our environmental initiatives. These trays are made from environmentally friendly materials, such as sugarcane bagasse, without using petroleum or forest resources. When incinerated, they help reduce the carbon dioxide emitted into the atmosphere, contributing to developing a sustainable society.

We hope vendors and visitors using these eco-trays will become more aware of environmental issues and feel encouraged to participate in eco-friendly activities.



In addition, we are engaging in waste sorting, litter collection, and local area cleaning as part of our environmental efforts. Please note that waste sorting methods vary depending on the location, so we kindly ask you to follow the labels on the waste bins and help us sort waste. Thank you for being so cooperative.

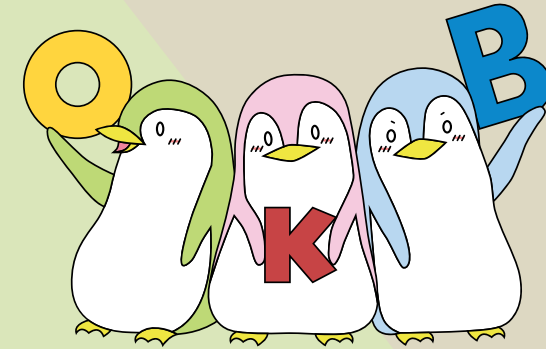

My ability is that I can speak five languages: English, Japanese, Spanish, Chinese and Korean. That's why I can speak Kansai dialect.

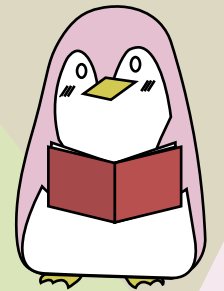
